Just yesterday the CDC issued the following statement:

*Guidance as of 3/15/2020*

Large events and mass gatherings can contribute to the spread of COVID-19 in the United States via travelers who attend these events and introduce the virus to new communities. Examples of large events and mass gatherings include conferences, festivals, parades, concerts, sporting events, weddings, and other types of assemblies. These events can be planned not only by organizations and communities but also by individuals.

Therefore, CDC, in accordance with its guidance for large events and mass gatherings, recommends that for the next 8 weeks, organizers (whether groups or individuals) cancel or postpone in-person events that consist of 50 people or more throughout the United States.

Events of any size should only be continued if they can be carried out with adherence to guidelines for protecting vulnerable populations, hand hygiene, and social distancing. When feasible, organizers could modify events to be virtual.

This recommendation does not apply to the day to day operation of organizations such as schools, institutes of higher learning, or businesses. This recommendation is made in an attempt to reduce introduction of the virus into new communities and to slow the spread of infection in communities already affected by the virus. This recommendation is not intended to supersede the advice of local public health officials.

As a result of these new recommendations and because of our concern for all the members of our congregation, we will be canceling our Sunday morning church services for the rest of this month. In order to help everyone stay connected – and spiritually fed – we will be posting video services online each Sunday morning which you can watch at home. (*Our live-streaming service should be back up by the first of April.*) If you don't have access to the internet, or if you would prefer – we can also send you a DVD or an audio CD of the service which you can listen to at your leisure.

We also want to be sure that everyone's physical, material, and medical needs are also covered during this time, so if there is anything you need – groceries, prescriptions delivered to your home, transportation to a doctor's office, etc. – please contact us at the following numbers:
